

Statement to the EU sanctions against Russia and Belarus

Dear valued business partner,

the crisis situation in Ukraine and the associated sanctions require all of us to be more diligent and vigilant in our business dealings.

In order to ensure the legality of our transactions, we as Murrelektronik GmbH always check our supplier network and our sales channels against the current EU regulations, including in particular Regulation (EU) 269/2014, Regulation (EU) 833/2014, Regulation (EU) 2021/821 and Regulation (EU) 2022/263 together with the respective amending and implementing regulations.

In connection with the EU sanctions mentioned, we have to inform you with this letter that only products from our **MIRO BT family** and our **Ethernet switches** can fall under the sanctions mentioned because of their technical properties.

The following product groups are also subject to the sanctions:

Seals of customs tariff number 40169300

Transformers of customs tariff number 85043300

Fixed resistors of customs tariff number 85332900

Semiconductor components of customs tariff number 8541xxxx

Electronic integrated circuits of customs tariff number 8542xxxx

Therefore, these products may not be brought directly or indirectly to Russia/Belarus or to the territories occupied by Russia for use. Please note that these products may not be delivered to Russia / Belarus via non-EU countries either, as this would circumvent the sanctions.

Please note that we cannot accept any responsibility for possible violations by you or your customers of the applicable legal sanctions.
